### **DOG POO**

Unfortunately more and more reports are being received of dog owners not picking up their dog's poo. It is not just the usual places that this problem is recurring but all over the Parish Therefore another plea to dog walkers and owners:

### **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AND DISPOSE OF THE BAG RESPONSIBLY.**

The local farmers are also asking for all dogs to be kept on a lead at this time of year due to the start of lambing.

### **BECKFIELDS**

Although it is not intended to align the beck to its original course Holker Estates have said that they will move the fence away from the beck to the side of the new footpath.

Holker Estates have also given approval for the positioning of a sand bag container on their land at Chapels.

### **SPEEDING**

The Speed Monitoring Vehicle has once more been in Kirkby and a number of motorists have been apprehended for exceeding the limit. It is hoped that a change of the speed at Grizebeck along the A5902 from 60 mph to 40 mph will be implemented following the meeting with the highways engineers.
